### What **YOU** need to know

**Methamphetamine**, also known as “*meth*,” “*speed*,” “*crank*,” or “*ice*” can be made from a number of household items. Most of our valued customers buy these products on a regular basis for the intended use.

Some people, however, see something quite different. Their intention is to make illegal drugs such as methamphetamine. Frequent or large quantity purchases of these and similar products may be a sign of illegal drug manufacturing.



#### Watch for:

- Over-the-counter cough, cold and allergy medicines containing pseudoephedrine or ephedrine
- Acetone
- Rubbing and isopropyl alcohol
- Iodine
- Starter fluid (ether)
- Gas additives (methanol)
- Drain cleaner (sulphuric acid)
- Lithium batteries
- Rock salt
- Matchbooks (red phosphorus)
- Lye
- Paint thinner
- Aluminum foil
- Glassware
- Coffee filters
- Propane tanks



#### BE AWARE, BUT BE SMART.
